The hamlet of Eaton is 20 miles south of Oneida via NYS-46 south for 15.8 miles and right on NYS-26 for 3.0 miles. Includes the village of Morrisville, and the hamlets of Eagleville, Eaton, Pecksport, Pierceville, Pine Woods, Pratts Hollow (considered the geographic center of New York State) and West Eaton.



Eaton Farm aka: Bates Farm Status: Abandoned Type: Private Burials: 1797–1827 Map Directions L-10 River Rd. Go south on Eaton St (becomes Eaton Rd/CR 105) 4.1 mi to the hamlet of Eaton. Go left (east) on NYS-26 for 0.1 mi to River Rd (CR 73). Go right (south) on River Rd for 1.3 mi. The cemetery is visible on the left at the edge of the east side of River Rd behind mailbox #2431. Maintenance provided annually by Mark Gallup. DAR marker is on the grave of Revolutionary War soldier, Jonathan Bates.


Landon Rd. Go south on Eaton St (becomes Eaton Rd/CR 105) 4.1 mi to the hamlet of Eaton. Go left (east) on NYS-26 for 0.2 mi to Landon Rd. Leave NYS-26 and go straight ahead on Landon Rd 0.15 mi. The fenced-in cemetery is on the left (north) side of Landon Rd. Cemetery is managed by the Eaton Village Cemetery Association. Revolutionary War veterans interred.



Status: Inactive Type: Community Burials: 1815–1936 Cramer Rd. Go east on US-20 for 0.2 mi. Go left (north) on North St (becomes Davis Corners Rd/CR 45) for 2.0 mi. Go right (east) on Cramer Rd 1.2 mi to cemetery on the left (north) side of the road, enclosed by various fences. The Town of Eaton has taken over care of this cemetery. Revolutionary War veteran interred.

Status: Active Type: Incorporated Burials: c. 1814– Cedar St. Go west 100 yards on US-20 and go right (north) on Cedar St for 0.2 mi. Cemetery is on the left (west) side of street next to Town of Eaton office parking lot. The cemetery boundaries are marked by Cedar St on the east, Williams St on the north, and hedge on the west. Managed by the Morrisville Rural Cemetery Association. Revolutionary War veterans interred.



Old West Eaton aka: Tayntor

Status: Endangered Type: Private Burials: 1821-1855 Wilcox Rd. Go south on Eaton St (Eaton Rd/CR 105) 1.2 mi. Go right (west) on Eagleville Rd (CR 103) for 2.0 mi to hamlet of West Eaton (junction of NYS-26). Go west curving around south on NYS-26 for 0.5 mi. Go right (west) on Wilcox Rd 0.5 mi. Cemetery is in a copse of apple trees on north side of Wilcox Rd 300 feet from the road. The barely visible cemetery is in an old apple orchard, very overgrown and neglected, surrounded by open farm fields.

Pine Woods

Status: Inactive Type: Community Burials: 1810–1980 K-10 NYS-46. Go east on US-20 for 3.6 mi to hamlet of Pine Woods. Go right (south) on NYS-46 for 0.7 mi. Cared for by the Pine Woods Cemetery Association, the cemetery is surrounded by an iron fence and is visible on the left (east) side of the road. Revolutionary War veteran interred.



Poor Farm

Status: Obliterated Type: Indigent Burials: 1828-1930 K-10


River Rd. Go south on Eaton St (becomes Eaton Rd/CR 105) 4.1 mi to the hamlet of Eaton. Go left (east) on NYS-26 for 0.1 mi. Go right (south) on River Rd (CR 73) 0.4 mi. Cemetery is located in a pasture approximately 50 feet from the west (right) side of River Rd and is adjacent to the south side of the old Gerrit Smith Infirmary property. While the cemetery area is visible, the cemetery itself is obliterated with no evidence of the cemetery, its remains or boundaries. The one marked burial of Huldah Root can no longer be found. Over 800 burials were recorded (per Eaton Town Clerk).

Houghton Lane. Go east on US-20 for 0.7 mi to Houghton Lane. Houghton Lane is at the eastern edge of Morrisville Village. (The road sign for Houghton Lane is located beside a larger sign for eastern outlet of Christian Hill Rd.) Go left (north) on Houghton Lane 0.15 mi. The unmarked entrance to the cemetery is between the last two houses on the left (west) side of Houghton Lane. Look for a lane through a wooded area. Travel 500 feet from the road to the

Go right (west) on Cemetery Rd 0.1 mi to cemetery entrance. Cemetery is clearly marked by a fence and is managed by the West Eaton Cemetery Association. Revolutionary War veterans
