What's Happening – Why I'm here

- I've been having a very serious problem in my home and on my property since March of this year.
- I and others are hearing a low frequency tone that is hurting my ears and vibrating my ear drums. It's gotten so bad it's vibrating my bones.
- It's hurting my hearing
- For quite some time, I thought the sound was my neighbors tractors until it go so bad that it was waking me up at night and severely hurting my ears
- I only hear it here, I hear it when I shut off all electricity in my home Other people hear it. I've been to a doctor and my hearing was perfect.

What is Resonance Frequency?

- Resonance explains why it's worse inside my home.
- Something is creating a low frequency tone that can travel a long distance. When it hits an object, e.g. my home it causes my home to vibrate.
- And I'm sure you remember from high school physics that when a sound or vibration hits an object, it vibrates at a high amplitude then where it originated.
- This vibration increases in amplitude in my home because it matches the frequency of the original sound.
- Why others may not be hearing it:
- Resonance frequency will only occur if the vibration of the target matches the original frequency The amplitude is dependent on the structure and the vibration allowed by that structure

Noise ordinance Chapter 140 -6 Town of Eaton

- The provisions and restrictions of this chapter shall not apply to the Agricultural Activities under s 308 of the Agricultural ad Markets Law Exception for conduct of sound agricultural practices as defined and construed
- Destroying the quality of your neighbor's life, is not a sound agricultural practice
- They have tractors, animals sounds, no one is complaining about
- No one is trying to stop them from farming.

If Farmers Say it's not their new equipment....

 If your equipment is fine, would you object to having an inspector come in to see if they can find any problems?

The Solution is not hard

- Farmer ask the manufacturer of their new milking system to fix the equipment that's causing the hum
- Insulate the building housing said equipment
- Be sure loud equipment is inside the milk house and not outside it
- Create a 10 foot wall of dirt between them and their neighbors
- and...

Plant pine trees that stop the sound from traveling involved in the past to fix other issues. can't do this alone. I have had to get DEC and Madison Soil and Water

If nothing is done...

- My Dad built this house with his friend in 1964
- Our family has lived here since then
- No problems until these farmers arrived and began greatly expanding their operation
- I'll lose my family home.
- I cannot tolerate this much longer
- I'll lose my lifetime investment
- It's already affecting my health and well-being
- Other residents are hearing it and
- It's Getting worse!

What I'm asking.....

- A town ordinance is being violated
- NYSEG commissioned a Sound Report which is right now with NYSEG Regulatory and Legal Departments
- Town of Eaton Codes Officer has been notified. He is waiting for the official results of the Sound Report
- NYSEG stated they may be able to give their conclusions to the Codes Officer
- Village lawyer should be notified so they can help with a ceaseand-desist order and to protect the town from this hazard
